

### **Grove Hill to Newport (E-F) 6 Miles**

- Once into the still waters, the 2<sup>nd</sup> dam and dam house should appear, self-portage your boat around the right-hand side of the dam to the lower end.
- Once at the base of the dam, there is a campground and small convenient store within a few hundred yards of the dam on the left along with a public boat ramp just below the campground.
- **NOTICE:** The owner of the campground absolutely requests that you call ahead of time before deciding to camp there, see red paper about campground information or call ahead with plenty of time to ensure open campsites (540-652-1075) or (540-652-8174). Showers available here.

### **Newport to Alma (F-G) 3 miles**

- During low water conditions this stretch has many small ledges, in high water it offers plenty of white water.
- Riverside Convenience lies directly above the bridge at Alma boat landing (G).

### **Alma to Whitehouse (G-H) 7 miles**

- Upon arriving at Whitehouse landing, there are a double set of bridges directly on top of the boat ramp there (H), with the boat ramp located on the right. **NOTICE:** All Aqua-blazers and 50 milers **MUST** stop at the double bridges in order to be shuttled around the 3<sup>rd</sup> dam to the next drop in point, as you cannot self-portage this dam.
